When the Salvation Army built the 2 buildings on the land they did what everyone does in Uruguay; build without permits, but what they didn't do was file the paperwork afterwards. Therefore now before they can legally transfer the land the government is making them legalize the building. In order to do that the government is fining the Salvation Army back taxes and other miscellaneous fines. The whole process is taking much longer then originally expected because of the Salvation Army is trying to reduce what is owed. We don't know how much is owed, but we are trying to find out because if it all being held up over a couple hundred dollars, which we might be able to pay. Please keep this in prayer.

We are also planning something special for the late spring with details to come. Keep your eyes open for the details.

Please continue to prayer for church speaking opportunities. We are not only trying to raise our financial support but most importantly we want to have 500 prayer partners. That is the support system back here in the States that will be making work possible in Uruguay.
